



PERMIT APPLICATION

LEAVE YOUR BUILDING PERMIT TO THE PROFESSIONALS

Integrity Buildings can provide professional services to assist with the permit application process for your post-frame structure. A Building Permit is typically required on any new structure of substantial size that is being added to a property. Exceptions may include farm buildings, pending local planning departments.

Permitting Assistance from Integrity is very cost effective considering the time, documentation and expertise required to submit a project for plan and permit review. Integrity commits to completing the process in a timely and professional manner, while also maintaining regular communication with the client throughout the process.

Ask your Integrity Building Specialist about our Permit Assistance Program! Fees can be added at the time of building contract, or at a later date. Your file will be assigned to a Permitting Professional, who will manage the entire process including gathering required documentation such as:

- Development Permit, if required
- Proof of Ownership or Land Title
- Real Property Report
- Disclosure of pertinent caveats, liens or encumbrances on the property

Based on the structure and provincial requirements, additional Professional Services may be necessary in order to obtain a building permit (ie. Architectural services, Geotechnical engineering, Civil engineering, Surveyor reports). Please note that fees for these services are not included in the Permit Assistance fees paid to Integrity, however Integrity can assist with facilitating the services required.

Should Integrity Buildings not be specifically engaged for these services, the Building Permit application, including form completion and fees, is the sole responsibility of the Customer.
